A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
- 2 health and the department of human services are responsible for
- 3 licensing, certifying, and monitoring several types of care
- 4 facilities. Although the departments perform inspections to
- 5 ensure a standard of quality of these facilities using state
- 6 moneys, the public currently cannot easily access the
- 7 information contained in the inspection reports. The
- 8 legislature finds that the public would benefit from greater
- 9 access to information on the quality and conditions of care
- 10 facilities in Hawaii.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 12 health and the department of human services to make available to
- 13 the public, free of charge, information collected from the
- 14 departments' inspections of care facilities.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 17 designated and to read as follows:

13	(b)	Each report shall be posted on the department of									
14	health's	health's website within days of the conclusion of each									
15	inspection and shall include but not be limited to the following										
16	information:										
17	(1)	The date of the inspection;									
18	(2)	A description of violations of relevant state laws or									
19		rules;									
20	(3)	Plans of correction and the status of corrective									
21		actions in response to any violations: and									

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1	(4) Other information regarding the quality and conditions							
2	of the facilities as the department of health deems							
3	appropriate in informing the public of their care							
4	options."							
5	SECTION 3. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is							
6	amended by adding a new section to part XIV to be appropriately							
7	designated and to read as follows:							
8	"§346- Inspections; public notice. (a) Beginning							
9	January 1, 2013, the department of human services shall post on							
10	its website electronic copies of reports for all inspections it							
11	performs on adult day care centers and community care foster							
12	family homes as that term is defined in section 346-331.							
13	(b) Each report shall be posted on the department of human							
14	services' website within days of the conclusion of each							
15	inspection and shall include but not be limited to the following							
16	information:							
17	(1) The date of the inspection;							
18	(2) A description of violations of relevant state laws or							
19	rules;							
20	(3) Plans of correction and the status of corrective							
21	actions in response to any violations; and
