RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Early College Admission tuition program. (a)
5	Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the
6	contrary, if a student finishes their high school education
7	graduation requirements before grade twelve, including
8	completion of the Standardized Achievement Test, the money that
9	would otherwise be allocated to a public school for the student
10	through the weighted student formula shall instead be allocated
11	as follows:
12	(1) Fifty per cent to the general fund; and
13	(2) Fifty per cent to the student in the form of a
14	tuition subsidy to any college within the
15	University of Hawaii system."
16	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
