A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC GUNS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 134-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§134-16 Restriction on possession, sale, gift, or
4 delivery of electric guns. (a) It shall be unlawful for any
5 person, including a licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, or
6 licensed dealer, to possess, offer for sale, hold for sale,
7 sell, give, lend, or deliver any electric gun.

8 (b) Any electric gun in violation of subsection (a) shall9 be confiscated and disposed of by the chief of police.

10 (c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement 11 officers of county police departments, law enforcement officers 12 of the department of public safety, [and] conservation and 13 resources enforcement officers of the department of land and 14 natural resources, and county liquor authority investigators, or 15 vendors providing electric guns to those entities; provided that 16 electric guns shall at all times remain in the custody and 17 control of the law enforcement officers of the county police 18 departments, the law enforcement officers of the department of HB HMS 2011-1145



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public safety, [or] the conservation and resources enforcement
 officers of the department of land and natural resources [-], and
 the county liquor authority investigators.

4 (d) The county police departments [of this State], the 5 department of public safety, [and] the department of land and 6 natural resources, and the county liquor authorities shall 7 maintain records regarding every electric gun in their 8 respective custody and control. The records shall report every 9 instance [of usage of the] in which an electric [guns; in particular, records] gun is used and shall be maintained in a 10 11 similar manner as for those [of] for the discharging of 12 firearms. The county police departments, the department of 13 public safety, [and] the department of land and natural 14 resources, and the county liquor authorities shall annually 15 report to the legislature regarding these records no later than 16 twenty days before the beginning of each regular session of the 17 legislature.

(e) The department of land and natural resources [and],
the department of public safety, and the county liquor
<u>authorities</u> shall ensure that each of their <u>respective</u>
conservation and resources enforcement officers [and], law
enforcement officers, and investigators who is authorized to use
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1 an electric gun and related equipment shall first receive 2 training from the manufacturer or from a manufacturer-approved 3 training program, as well as by manufacturer-certified or 4 approved instructors in the use of electric guns prior to 5 deployment of the electric guns and related equipment in public. 6 Training for conservation and resources enforcement officers of 7 the department of land and natural resources [and], law 8 enforcement officers of the department of public safety, and 9 county liquor authority investigators may be done concurrently 10 to ensure cost savings.

(f) The conservation and resources enforcement program of the department of land and natural resources shall meet the law enforcement accreditation or recognition standards of the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., in the use of electric guns prior to obtaining electric guns, related equipment, and training for the use of the electric guns.

(g) For the purposes of this section:

19 <u>"County liquor authority" means the county liquor</u>

20 commissions or liquor control adjudication boards established

21 pursuant to part II of chapter 281.



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"County liquor authority investigator" or "investigator"
means any investigator employed by a county liquor authority
under section 281-17(a)(5)."
