BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Before any offeror enters into a contract to perform
4 services in excess of \$25,000 for any governmental agency, the
5 offeror shall certify that the services to be performed will be
6 performed under the following conditions:

7 Wages. The services to be rendered shall be performed by
8 employees paid at wages or salaries not less than the wages paid
9 to public officers and employees for similar work [-,] in the
10 State.

11 Compliance with labor laws. All applicable laws of the 12 federal and state governments relating to workers' compensation, 13 unemployment compensation, payment of wages, and safety [will] 14 <u>shall</u> be fully complied with."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
