BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 363, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§363-</u> Demonstrations at cemeteries; prohibited;		
5	penalties. (a) No person may carry out a demonstration at a		
6	state or county veterans cemetery except as approved under		
7	subsection (b) by the council of the county in which the		
8	cemetery is located.		
9	(b) No council shall grant approval to carry out a		
10	demonstration during the period beginning sixty minutes before		
11	and ending sixty minutes after a funeral, memorial service, or		
12	ceremony is scheduled to be held, any part of which		
13	demonstration:		
14	(1) Takes place within one hundred and fifty feet of a		
15	road, pathway, or other route of ingress to or egress		
16	from the cemetery property, and includes, as part of		
17	the demonstration, any individual wilfully making or		
18	assisting in the making of any noise or diversion that

2		of the funeral, memorial service, or ceremony; or		
3	(2)	Is within three hundred feet of the cemetery and		
4		impedes the access to or egress from the cemetery.		
5	(c)	For purposes of this section, "demonstration" means:		
6	(1)	Any picketing or similar conduct;		
7	(2)	Any oration, speech, use of sound amplification		
8		equipment or device, or similar conduct that is not		
9		part of a funeral, memorial service, or ceremony;		
10	(3)	The display of any placard, banner, flag, or similar		
11		device, unless such a display is part of a funeral,		
12		memorial service, or ceremony; or		
13	(4)	The distribution of any handbill, pamphlet, leaflet,		
14		or other written or printed matter other than a		
15		program distributed as part of a funeral, memorial		
16		service, or ceremony.		
17	(d)	Any person who violates this section shall be guilty		
18	18 of a petty misdemeanor."
