- SECTION 1. Chapter 128, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 Interdisciplinary working group. (a) There is 4 established within the civil defense agency an interdisciplinary 5 working group that shall develop an integrated management system 6 for the sharing of information across public agencies during the 7 preparation and planning for mass events. 8 9 For the purpose of this section, "mass event" means any occurrence either unplanned and arising naturally or resulting 10 from a planned scheduled event that potentially involves a high 11 risk of danger or harm to a large number of people or that may 12 have a significant impact on the health and public safety of the 13 14 people of the State. (b) The working group shall be chaired by the director of 15 16 civil defense and shall be composed of the following members:
- 17 (1) The director of health or the director's designee;

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(2)	The director of transportation or the director's
	designee;
(3)	A representative from the state department of defense;
(4)	A representative from the emergency medical services
	and injury prevention branch of the department of
	health;
(5)	The mayor of each county or a designated
	representative;
(6)	The chief of police of each county or a designated
	representative; and
<u>(7)</u>	The fire chief of each county or a designated
	representative.
<u>(c)</u>	The working group shall prepare a written memorandum
of agreement that shall include standards and protocols for	
15 mutual cooperation, including the sharing of emergency	
16 information and video surveillance in exercises, testing, or	
other training activities conducted in preparation for a mass
