## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§711-A</u> Aggravated harassment by online impersonation.		
5	(1) A person commits the offense of aggravated harassment by		
6	online harassment if that person commits the offense of		
7	harassment by online impersonation as provided in section 711-B		
8	and has been convicted of harassment by online impersonation		
9	under section 711-B within five years preceding the instant		
10	offense.		
11	(2) Aggravated harassment by online impersonation is a		
12	class C felony.

15	that person uses the name or persona of another person to create

3 SECTION 2. Section 711-1106.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "[**+]§711-1106.6[<del>]</del>] Harassment by impersonation.** (1) A 6 person commits the offense of harassment by impersonation if 7 that person poses as another person, without the express 8 authorization of [that] the other person, and makes or causes to 9 be made, either directly or indirectly, a transmission of any personal information of the other person to another by any oral 10 11 statement, any written statement, or any statement conveyed by 12 any electronic means, with the intent to harass, annoy, or alarm 13 any person.

14 (2) Harassment by impersonation is a misdemeanor [-];
15 provided that, if the offense is committed with the intent to
16 solicit a response by emergency services personnel, then the

17 offense is a class C felony.

18 (3) For the purposes of this section:

"Personal information" means information associated with an
actual person that is a name, an address, <u>a domain address</u>, a
telephone number, or an electronic mail address.

1 "Pose" means to falsely represent oneself, directly or 2 indirectly, as another person or persons." 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 5 begun before its effective date. 6 SECTION 4. In codifying the new sections added by section 7 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 8 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 9 the new sections in this Act. 10 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.

#### Report Title:

Computers; Online Harassment; Aggravated Online Harassment; Harassment by Impersonation

#### Description:

Makes the use of another person's name or persona to create a web page on or to post one or more messages on a commercial social networking site, without the permission of the other person, and with the intent to harm, defraud, intimidate, or threaten any person, a misdemeanor. Makes the repeated commission of this offense a class C felony. Provides that harassment by impersonation, if committed with the intent to solicit a response by emergency services personnel, is a class C felony. Effective January 7, 2059. (HD618 HD1)
