A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 General fund formulation. Beginning in fiscal "§304A-5 year 2012-2013, and every year thereafter, the general fund 6 budget appropriations for the University of Hawaii shall be 7 based upon the amount of funding required per student. 8 Specifically, funding shall be based upon a student weighted 9 formula that factors into account the number of enrolled 10 students, their classification as graduate or undergraduate, 11 their enrollment in a program that leads to a degree, and the 12 accumulated credit hours for each student under that 13 classification and program. Funding per student shall be reduced after a specified number of credit hours have been 14 15 accumulated, depending on the student's graduate or 16 undergraduate classification and the student's enrollment in a 17 degree program or otherwise.



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1	For fiscal year 2012-2013, the amount of general fund
2	budget appropriations shall be based on student enrollment data
3	from fiscal year 2011-2012."
4	SECTION 2. Section 304A-2101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	repealed.
6	[" [§304A-2101] General fund budget appropriations;
7	formulation. (a) The general-fund-budget appropriations for
8	the university shall be an amount not less than three times and
9	not-greater than five times the amount of regular-tuition and
10	related fee revenues estimated for that fiscal year.
11	(b) Any general fund-budget-appropriation for the
12	university for operating purposes for any fiscal year shall
13	include the consideration of:
14	(1) The fiscal condition of the State;
15	(2) Enrollment;
16	(3) Access to educational opportunity;
17	(4) The mix of resident and nonresident students; and
18	(5) Community service and noninstruction programs.
19	(c) No revenue received by the university pursuant to the
20	University of Hawaii tuition and fees special fund established
21	under section [304A-2153] may be used by the governor or the
22	director of finance as a justification for reducing any budget



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1	request or allotment to the university unless the university
2	requests such a reduction."]
3	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and
6	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7	year 2012-2013 for the University of Hawaii to develop the
8	funding model established under this Act and to upgrade their
9	computer systems technology to implement the funding model.
10	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
11	of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
12	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
