RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 92-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "§92-4 Executive meetings. (a) A board may hold an 3 executive meeting closed to the public upon an affirmative vote, 4 taken at an open meeting, of two-thirds of the members present; 5 provided the affirmative vote constitutes a majority of the 6 members to which the board is entitled. A meeting closed to the 7 public shall be limited to matters exempted by section 92-5. 8 9 The reason for holding such a meeting shall be publicly 10 announced and the vote of each member on the question of holding a meeting closed to the public shall be recorded, and entered 11 12 into the minutes of the meeting. Any action taken by a board in an executive meeting 13 14 shall be reported to the public when the board reconvenes in the

open meeting at which the executive meeting is held."
