BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 92-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§92-4 Executive meetings. (a) A board may hold an executive meeting that is closed to the public upon an 4 5 affirmative vote, taken at an open meeting, of two-thirds of the members present; provided the affirmative vote constitutes a 6 7 majority of the members to which the board is entitled. A 8 meeting closed to the public shall be limited to matters 9 exempted by section 92-5. The reason for holding such a meeting 10 shall be publicly announced and the vote of each member on the 11 question of holding a meeting that is closed to the public shall 12 be recorded $[\tau]$ and entered into the minutes of the meeting. 13 (b) Any final action taken by a board in an executive 14 meeting shall be reported to the public when the board

15 reconvenes in the open meeting at which the executive meeting is
16 held; provided that, in describing the final action taken by the

Requires any final action taken in an executive meeting to be reported when the board reconvenes at the open meeting, provided that the information reported shall not be inconsistent with the purpose for which the executive meeting was convened. Effective January 7, 2050. (SD1)
