A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 481, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§481- Automatic renewal clauses. (a) Any person who
5	sells or offers to sell any products or services to a consumer
6	pursuant to a consumer contract that has a specified term of
7	more than one month and an automatic renewal clause under which
8	the contract will automatically renew for a specified term of
9	more than one month unless the consumer cancels the contract,
10	shall disclose the automatic renewal clause and the procedure by
11	which the consumer can cancel automatic renewal of the consumer
12	contract clearly and conspicuously in the consumer contract.
13	(b) Any person who sells or offers to sell any products or
14	services to a consumer pursuant to a consumer contract that has
15	a specified contract term of twelve months or more, under which
16	the contract will automatically renew for a specified term of
17	more than one month unless the consumer cancels the consumer
18	contract, shall notify the consumer clearly and conspicuously:

1	(1)	That the consumer contract will automatically renew
2		unless the consumer cancels the contract;
3	(2)	How to cancel the contract; and
4	(3)	The deadline by which the consumer shall respond to
5		cancel the consumer contract and prevent automatic
6		renewal.
7	The notic	e provided to the consumer under this subsection shall
8	be sent t	o the consumer no less than thirty days and no more
9	than sixt	y days before the date upon which the consumer shall
10	respond u	nder paragraph (3).
. 11	(c)	The notice to the consumer required by this section
12	may be pr	ovided electronically if the:
13	(1)	Transaction for sale of products or services was
14		conducted electronically at the election of the
15		consumer and in compliance with the requirements of
16		chapter 489E, the uniform electronic transactions act;
17		<u>or</u>
18	(2)	Consumer elects to receive electronic communications
19		and provides a valid electronic-mail address for the
20		purpose of receiving the notice required by this
21		section.

1	(d)	Any person who violates this section or fails to	
2	cancel an	automatic renewal contract upon consumer request shall	
3	be deemed	to have engaged in an unfair method of competition and	
4	unfair or	deceptive act or practice in the conduct of any trade	
5	or commer	ce within the meaning of section 480-2.	
6	(e)	This section shall not apply to any:	
7	(1)	Financial institution subject to chapter 412 to the	
8		extent that the financial institution is engaged in	
9 .		activities regulated pursuant to chapter 412; and	
10	(2)	Insurer subject to chapter 431 to the extent that the	
11		insurer is engaged in activities regulated pursuant to	
12		chapter 431.	
13	(f)	For purposes of this section:	
14	<u>"Cle</u>	arly and conspicuously" means in larger type than the	
15	surroundi	ng text; in contrasting type, font, or color to the	
16	surrounding text of the same size; or set off from the		
17	surroundi	ng text of the same size by symbols or other marks in a	
18	manner that clearly calls attention to the language. In the		
19	case of an audio disclosure, "clear and conspicuous" and		
20	"clearly and conspicuously" mean in a volume and cadence		
21	sufficien	t to be readily audible and understandable.	

- 1 "Consumer" shall have the same meaning as in section
- 2 480-1."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
