Section 453D-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(c) For an applicant who graduated from an accredited 4 educational institution as specified in subsection (a) (1) before 5 July 1, 2007, the department shall also deem acceptable: 6 For practicum intern experience, written certification (1)7 from an official of the institution of higher 8 education attesting [that the applicant has completed 9 the academic terms, graduate credit hours, and 10 supervised client contact hours in subsection (a) (2) 11 and] that the applicant's practicum intern experience 12 is equivalent to a mental health graduate level 13 practicum program; and 14 For post-graduate experience, written certification (2)15 from an officer and the clinical supervisor of the 16 agency at which the applicant has earned experience 17 attesting [that-the-applicant has completed the hours 18 of experience and supervision in subsection (a)-(3)
