RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-1303.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
is amended to read as follows:

3 "\$302A-1303.6 Weighted student formula. (a) Based upon 4 recommendations from the committee on weights, the board of 5 education, not less than annually, shall adopt a weighted 6 student formula for the allocation of moneys to public schools 7 that takes into account the educational needs of each student. 8 The department, upon the receipt of appropriated moneys, shall 9 use the weighted student formula to allocate funds to public schools. Principals shall expend moneys provided to the 10 11 principals' schools.

12 (b) Beginning in fiscal year 2011-2012, the schools on the 13 islands of Molokai and Lanai and in the Hana district of Maui 14 shall be exempt from this section. Beginning in fiscal year 15 2012-2013, schools in areas where there is no other school that 16 includes the same grade levels within a mile radius shall be 17 exempt from this section.

(c) This section shall only apply to charter schools for
fiscal years in which the charter schools elect pursuant to
section 302B-13 to receive allocations according to the weighted
student formula."

5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
