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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATIVE HAWAIIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as
2	amended, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>S</u> Native Hawaiian research, science, and technology
5.	park. (a) The board of trustees of the office of Hawaiian
6	affairs and the Hawaiian homes commission shall jointly
7	establish, with the assistance of native Hawaiian business
8	organizations, a native Hawaiian research, science, and
9	technology park that shall serve as an incubator and resource
10	center for native Hawaiian entrepreneurs.
11	(b) The board of trustees and the Hawaiian homes
12	commission, as applicable, are authorized in accordance with law
13	to:
14	(1) Identify and seek the assistance of native Hawaiian
15	business organizations with the potential or \cdot
16	willingness to participate in the development of a
17	native Hawaiian research, science, and technology
18	park;

17	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended	
18	by adding	a new section to be appropriately designated and to	
19	read as f	ollows:

21	<u>park.</u> (a) The board and the Hawaiian homes commission shall	
22	jointly e	stablish, with the assistance of native Hawaiian

4	(b)	The board of trustees and the Hawaiian homes

15	<u>(3)</u>	Issue revenue bonds to assist in the financing of the

18		technology;
19	(4)	Enter into long-term leases with native Hawaiian

3	(c) The board and the Hawaiian homes commission shall		
4	select and designate qualified personnel to administer and		
5	effectuate the objectives of the research, science, and		
6	technology park."		
7	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
8	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
9	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012, and the		
10	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
11	2012-2013, for the purpose of establishing a native Hawaiian		
12	research, science, and technology park.		
13	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of		
14	Hawaiian affairs for the purposes of this Act.		
15	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general		
16	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
17	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012, and the		
18	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
19	2012-2013, for the purpose of establishing a native Hawaiian		
20	research, science, and technology park.		
21	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		

22 Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.



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1 SECTION 5. The provisions of the amendments made by this 2 Act to the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended, are 3 declared to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, 4 or phrase, or the application thereof to any person or 5 circumstances is held ineffective because there is a requirement 6 of having the consent of the United States to take effect, then 7 that portion only shall take effect upon the granting of consent by the United States and effectiveness of the remainder of these 8 9 amendments or the application thereof shall not be affected. 10 SECTION 6. New statutory material is underscored. 11 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011. 12
