A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOMELESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many homeless persons are known to thrive better when they have ready access 2 3 to familiar support groups or family members. The intent of the 4 return-to-home program is to ensure that those individuals who 5 find themselves homeless in the islands are able to reconnect with support networks ready and able to receive them. 6 7 The purpose of this Act is to establish a return-to-home program for qualified homeless individuals. 8 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by adding a new section to part XVII to be appropriately 11 designated and to read as follows:

12 "§346- Return-to-home program. (a) There is

13 established within the department, a voluntary homeless

14 assistance program to be known as the return-to-home program to

15 provide eligible homeless individuals with assistance in being

16 reunited with family and relatives in the individual's home

17 state. The department shall administer the program.

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1	<u>(b)</u>	No individual who is homeless shall be eligible to
2	participa	te in the program unless:
3	(1)	The individual's participation is completely
4		voluntary;
5	(2)	The individual has a support system in place in the
6		individual's home state that is willing to receive and
7		accommodate the individual;
8	(3)	The individual, if on parole, probation, or awaiting a
9		court hearing or sentencing, has proper clearance from
10		the court to participate in the program;
11	(4)	The individual is indigent and lacks the financial
12		resources necessary to secure transportation to return
13		to the individual's home state; and
14	(5)	The individual has been receiving social services for
15		a period of no less than one year and the receipt of
16		such social services has been documented.
17	(c)	The department shall actively seek the participation
18	of local	airlines, cruise lines, charter companies, homeless
19	programs,	travel agencies, and the visitor industry to
20	<u>coordinat</u>	e and implement the program.
21	<u>(d)</u>	The department shall also assist program participants
22	with nece	ssary and proper preparations for the return trip,
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1	including proper identification, orientation relating to airport		
2	security, and the basics of personal care, and shall follow up		
3	with each individual within one month of the individual's return		
4	to the individual's home state to assess efforts at successful		
5	reunification with any family or support system.		
6	(e) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter		
7	91 to develop the return-to-home program and adopt standards for		
8	its implementation."		
9	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
10	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
11	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 to		
12	implement the return-to-home program, including all program		
13	costs and the hiring of necessary staff.		
14	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
15	human services for the purposes of this Act.		
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
