RELATING TO HAWAIIAN EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 302H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending section 302H-1 to read:

4 "[4] §302H-1[]] Hawaiian language medium education program; 5 established. The Hawaiian language medium education program 6 [may] shall be established as a complete educational program or 7 schooling experience provided to students in the medium of the 8 Hawaiian language. The educational objectives of this program 9 shall take into consideration how its content integrates with 10 Hawaiian language and culture curricula and Hawaiian language 11 medium curricula offered at the preschool and college levels, 12 may be the same as the English language medium program, and may 13 fulfill unique Hawaiian language medium education program 14 qoals."

15

2. By amending section 302H-3 to read:

16 "[+]§302H-3[+] Office of Hawaiian language medium
17 education; personnel. The department of education [may] shall
18 create a separate office of Hawaiian language medium education
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1 for the direction and control of the program. The department 2 [may] shall employ necessary personnel gualified by training and 3 experience to direct and supervise the types of instruction and 4 special services specified in this chapter. Publicly funded 5 institutions of higher education [may] shall create teacher 6 preparation programs to ensure that pre-service training is 7 provided to students interested in teaching elementary and 8 secondary students in the Hawaiian language."

3. By amending section 302H-4 to read:

10 "[4] §302H-4[4] Facilities or transportation. When fifteen 11 or more qualified children in any one departmental school 12 district wish to enroll in the Hawaiian language medium 13 education program, the superintendent of education [may] shall 14 provide facilities for a Hawaiian language medium education 15 program or provide transportation to the nearest schooling site 16 providing the program, including a charter school site or 17 laboratory school site."

4. By amending section 302H-5 to read:

"[+]§302H-5[+] Student performance. The department of
education [may] shall develop and use multiple assessment
strategies and instruments to assess student achievement and
performance and to evaluate the effectiveness of teaching



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1 strategies and methods being used in the Hawaiian language
2 medium education program."

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5. By amending section 302H-6 to read:

4 "[+] §302H-6[+] Hawaiian language medium state education 5 agency; districts and complex areas. The department of 6 education [may] shall establish a Hawaiian language medium state 7 education agency with the capability of operating districts and 8 complex areas on an equal basis with any other districts and 9 complex areas of the department. The Hawaiian language medium 10 state education agency shall encompass the entire State[,]; may 11 administer schools consisting of geographically noncontiguous 12 classes, boarding schools, charter schools, or cyber schools; 13 and may share facilities, administration, programs, resources, 14 and funding with other public, charter, and private schools and 15 colleges as appropriate. All schools and programs taught 16 through the medium of the Hawaiian language shall be included in 17 the Hawaiian language medium state education agency."

18 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
