A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TRANSFER OF THE STADIUM AUTHORITY TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 109-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) There shall be within the [department-of accounting 4 and general-services] University of Hawaii for administrative 5 purposes only, a stadium authority whose responsibility shall be 6 to maintain, operate, and manage the stadium and facilities 7 attached thereto and to provide for the maintenance, operation, 8 management, and promotion of the Kapolei recreational sports complex. The authority shall consist of nine members who shall 9 10 be appointed by the governor in the manner prescribed by section 11 26-34. Each member of the authority shall have been a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State for at least 12 five years next preceding the member's appointment. 13 The 14 president of the University of Hawaii and the superintendent of 15 education shall be ex officio members of the authority but shall 16 not vote."



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SECTION 2. All rights, powers, functions, and duties of
 the stadium authority are transferred to the University of
 Hawaii.

All officers and employees whose functions are transferred
by this Act shall be transferred with their functions and shall
continue to perform their regular duties upon their transfer,
subject to the state personnel laws and this Act.

8 No officer or employee of the State having tenure shall 9 suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service credit, 10 vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or privilege as 11 a consequence of this Act, and the officer or employee may be 12 transferred or appointed to a civil service position without the necessity of examination; provided that the officer or employee 13 14 possesses the minimum qualifications for the position to which 15 transferred or appointed; and provided that subsequent changes in status may be made pursuant to applicable civil service and 16 17 compensation laws.

18 An officer or employee of the State who does not have 19 tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil 20 service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a 21 civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority, 22 prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee



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benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
 provided that the officer or employee possesses the minimum
 qualifications for the position to which transferred or
 appointed.

5 If an office or position held by an officer or employee 6 having tenure is abolished, the officer or employee shall not 7 thereby be separated from public employment, but shall remain in the employment of the State with the same pay and classification 8 and shall be transferred to some other office or position for 9 10 which the officer or employee is eligible under the personnel 11 laws of the State as determined by the head of the department or 12 the governor.

SECTION 3. All appropriations, records, equipment, machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used, acquired, or held by the stadium authority relating to the functions transferred to the University of Hawaii shall be transferred with the functions to which they relate.

19 SECTION 4. It is not the intent of this Act to jeopardize 20 the receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of 21 the estate or any agency thereof to the holders of any bond 22 issued by the State or by any such agency, and to the extent,



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1 and only to the extent, necessary to effectuate this intent, the 2 governor may modify the strict provisions of this Act, but shall 3 promptly report any such modification with reasons therefor to 4 the legislature at its next session thereafter for review by the 5 legislature.

6 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
