BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 346-331, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

amended by amending the definition of "community care foster

4 ""Community care foster family home" or "home" means a home

that, for the purposes of this part:

(1) Is regulated by the department in accordance with rules that are equitable in relation to rules that

govern expanded adult residential care homes;

(2) Is issued a certificate of approval by the department or its designee to provide, for a fee, twenty-four-hour living accommodations, including personal care and homemaker services, for not more than two adults at any one time, at least one of whom shall be a medicaid recipient, who are at the nursing facility level of care, who are unrelated to the foster family,

and who are receiving the services of a licensed home

and community-based case management agency; provided

that the department, in its discretion, may certify a

1		home for a third adult who is at the nursing level of
2		care and a medicaid recipient; provided that the
3		primary [and substitute caregivers are certified nurse
4		aides who have] caregiver is a certified nurse aide as
5		defined in section 457A-1.5 who has completed a state-
6		approved training program and other training as
