A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 227D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The governing body of the authority shall consist of a 4 board of directors having [thirteen] eleven voting members. 5 [Three members] One member from the general public shall be 6 appointed by the governor [for staggered-terms] pursuant to section 26-34, [except-that one of these members] and shall be a 7 resident of the county of Hawaii. One member shall be appointed 8 9 by the president of the senate. One member shall be appointed 10 by the speaker of the house of representatives. These three 11 members shall serve staggered terms of four years each; provided 12 that the first person appointed by the governor shall serve two 13 years, the first person appointed by the president of the senate 14 shall serve three years, and the first person appointed by the 15 speaker of the house of representatives shall serve four years. Thereafter, subsequent appointees shall each serve a term of 16 17 four years. The members shall be selected on the basis of their 18 knowledge, interest, and proven expertise in [,-but-not limited HB LRB 11-0865.doc

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1 to, one or more] no less than one of the following fields: 2 finance, commerce and trade, corporate management, marketing, economics, engineering, energy management, real estate 3 4 development[, property management,] or management, aquaculture, 5 and ocean science. [The chairperson and secretary of the research advisory committee shall serve on the board.] The 6 7 director of business, economic development, and tourism, the 8 [chairperson of the board of land and natural resources, the 9 president of the University of Hawaii,] chancellor of the 10 University of Hawaii at Hilo, the mayor of the county of Hawaii, 11 an appointed member from the board of the high technology 12 development corporation, [and] an appointed member from the 13 board of the Hawaii strategic development corporation, and a 14 member of the board of the office of Hawaiian affairs, or their designated representatives, shall serve as ex officio, voting 15 16 members of the board. The tenants of the authority shall elect 17 two members to the board from among the tenants of the 18 authority [, of which one member shall serve a two-year term, and 19 one member shall serve a four-year-term. In electing-the tenant 20 members, each tenant shall be entitled to cast one vote for each 21 member position]. To participate in the election of tenant 22 members or to serve as a tenant representative on the authority, HB LRB 11-0865.doc

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1	a tenant shall be an owner or active manager of a business with
2	its principal place of business located within Hawaii. Any
3	tenant who ceases to be a tenant of the authority shall be
4	immediately disqualified from participating in the election of
5	tenant members or from serving as a tenant representative on the
6	authority. The tenant members shall be recused from voting on
7	setting lease rents, water rates, or utility rates, but may
8	participate in [discussions. The director of business, economic
9	development, and tourism shall-serve as the-chairperson-until
10	such time as a chairperson is elected by the board from the
11	membership.] decision-making on other items. The board shall
12	elect a chairperson, vice chairperson, secretary, and other
13	officers as it deems necessary."
14	SECTION 2. Section 227D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	"[+]§227D-4[+] Research advisory committee. The authority
17	shall appoint a research advisory committee for the purpose of
1 8	obtaining expert and specialized counsel and advice on matters
19	relating to scientific research [and may include as members of
20	the committee officers and employees of any government
21	department or agency or members of the scientific community;
22	provided-that-at-least two-members of the-board shall-be
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1	appointed to the committee.] projects proposed to be located at
2	the authority's ocean science and technology park; provided that
3	four members shall be appointed from the board of directors of
4	the authority and shall include the board members representing
5	the University of Hawaii at Hilo, high technology development
6	corporation, and Hawaii strategic development corporation.
7	Three other members shall be selected by the committee and shall
8	reside in the county of Hawaii. Members of the advisory
9	committee shall elect the chairperson and secretary of the
10	committee[, who shall serve as members of the board]. The
11	authority may assign its own staff to aid and assist the
12	committee and may reimburse any member of the committee for
13	necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the member's
14	work for the authority."
15	SECTION 3. Upon the effective date of this Act and
16	notwithstanding section 26-34(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, and
17	any other law to the contrary, the terms of all the members of
18	the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii Authority's board of
19	directors shall expire; provided that the ex officio board
20	members, with the exception of the president of the University

21 of Hawaii and the chairperson of land and natural resources, and 22 the tenant board members may continue to serve in a holdover



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capacity pursuant to section 26-34(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes,
 until such time as the board member's successor is nominated and
 appointed, or elected as the case may be.

4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
