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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1 | SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to: |
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| 2 | (1) Increase the solid waste management surcharge; and |
| 3 | (2) Extend the surcharge to solid waste shipped outside |
| 4 | the State for disposal. |
| 5 | The legislature finds that the surcharge increase is |
| 6 | necessary to promote the public health. Additional revenue is |
| 7 | needed by the department of health for the operation of its |
| 8 | environmental management program. Furthermore, additional |
| 9 | revenue would enable the legislature to reduce the general fund |
| 10 | subsidy for the program. |
| 11 | SECTION 2. Section 342G-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is |
| 12 | amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted |
| 13 | and to read as follows: |
| 14 | ""Solid waste shipping facility" means any facility that |
| 15 | receives and prepares solid waste for shipping and ultimate |
| 16 | disposal outside the State." |
| 17 | SECTION 3. Section 342G-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is |
| 18 | amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: |



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| 1 | "(a) There is established a solid waste management |

| 3 | 55 cents per ton of solid waste [disposed]: |
| 4 | (1) Disposed of within the State at permitted or |

| 6 | (2) Shipped out-of-state by solid waste shipping |
| 7 | facilities. |
| 8 | The surcharge shall be paid by the person or entity doing the |
| 9 | disposal[-] or shipping. The owner or operator of the facility |
| 10 | shall transfer all moneys collected from the surcharge to the |
| 11 | department through a quarterly reporting and payment schedule. |
| 12 | Estimates of quarterly solid waste disposal shall be submitted |
| 13 | prior to the first day of each quarter and the transfer of |
| 14 | moneys collected shall occur within thirty days of the end of |
| 15 | each quarter." |
| 16 | SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed |
| 17 | and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. |
| 18 | SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011. |
