### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to change the
2	formula for the crediting of unused sick leave when a new public
3	employee retires or leaves government service. The legislature
4	finds that this Act is necessary to reduce the public employers'
5	contributions to the employees' retirement system.
6	SECTION 2. Section 88-63, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	"[+]§88-63[+] Credit for unused sick leave. (a) This
9	subsection applies to a public employee who first entered
10	service before July 1, 2011.
11	A public employee, to whom this subsection applies, who
12	retires or leaves government service in good standing with sixty
13	days or more of unused sick leave shall be entitled to
14	additional service credit in the retirement system as follows:
15	(1) An employee with sixty days of unused sick leave to
16	the employee's credit shall have the employee's years
17	of service increased by three months for the purpose
18	of computing the employee's retirement allowance.
