BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 601-3.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) There is established in the state treasury a special
fund to be known as the judiciary computer system special fund.
Moneys collected from administrative fees pursuant to section
287-3(a) and fees pursuant to sections 607-4(b)(10) and
607-5(c)(32) shall be deposited into the fund. <u>Fifty per cent</u>

8 of the fees collected pursuant to section 607-4(b)(7), (8), and

9 (9) shall also be deposited into the fund."

SECTION 2. Section 607-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

12 "(a) The fees prescribed by subsection (b) shall be paid to the clerk of the district court as costs of court by the 13 person instituting the action or proceeding, or offering the 14 15 paper for filing, or causing the document to be issued or the services to be performed in the district court; provided that 16 nothing in subsection (b) shall apply to cases of adults charged 17 with the commission of a crime $[\tau]$ or minors referred to the 18 2011-1851 HB823 SD1 SMA.doc
