A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 6, OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF EXCESS REVENUES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an amendment to article VII, section 6, of the Hawaii State 2 3 Constitution to amend the requirement that excess general fund 4 revenues be returned to taxpayers of the State as a tax refund 5 or be deposited into one or more funds to serve as a temporary 6 supplemental source of funding in times of an emergency, 7 economic downturn, or an unforeseen reduction in revenue and 8 allow the legislature to deposit excess general fund revenues 9 into one or more funds to reduce unfunded liabilities for 10 pension benefits and other post-employment benefits for state 11 employees.

SECTION 2. Article VII, section 6, of the Hawaii StateConstitution is amended to read as follows:

"DISPOSITION OF EXCESS REVENUES

15 Section 6. Whenever the state general fund balance at the 16 close of each of two successive fiscal years exceeds five

1 years, the legislature in the next regular session shall provide 2 for a tax refund or tax credit to the taxpayers of the State, or 3 make a deposit into one or more funds, as provided by law, which 4 shall serve as temporary supplemental sources of funding for the 5 State in times of an emergency, economic downturn, or unforeseen 6 reduction in revenue, as provided by law[-]; provided that if 7 general fund revenues in any one fiscal year are projected to 8 exceed general fund revenues in the previous fiscal year by 9 seven percent or more, the legislature shall deposit an amount 10 equal to the excess general fund revenues into one or more funds, as provided by law, to reduce unfunded liabilities for 11 pension benefits and other post-employment benefits for 12 13 employees of the State." 14 SECTION 3. The question printed on the ballot shall be as 15 follows: 16 "Whenever general fund revenues in any one fiscal year are 17 projected to exceed general fund revenues in the previous 18 fiscal year by seven percent or more, shall the legislature 19 be required to deposit an amount equal to the excess 20 general fund revenues into one or more funds, as provided 21 by law, to reduce unfunded liabilities for pension benefits
