9	(1)	Loss of full-time work with a regular employer made it	
10		economically unfeasible to continue part-time	
11		employment;	
12	(2)	The part-time employment was outside of the	
13		individual's customary occupation and would not have	
14		been considered suitable work under section 12-5-	
15		55(c), Hawaii Administrative Rules, at the time that	
16		the individual accepted the part-time employment;	
17	(3)	The employer failed to provide sufficient advance	
18		notice of a work schedule change;
