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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MANDATORY HEALTH COVERAGE FOR USE OF THE LIFEBED INTELLIGENT MEDICAL VIGILANCE SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is the right of
2	all people in Hawaii to have access to health care in all its
3	facets, including use of the Lifebed Intelligent Medical
4	Vigilance System. The public relies heavily on health insurance
5	policies to provide adequate medical care. However, current
6	policies do not include coverage for use of the Lifebed
7	Intelligent Medical Vigilance System.
8	The purpose of this Act is to require health insurance
9	policies in the State to provide coverage for use of the Lifebed
10	Intelligent Medical Vigilance System.
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 431:10A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
13	and to read as follows:
14	"§431:10A- Coverage for use of the Lifebed Intelligent
15	Medical Vigilance System. Notwithstanding any provision to the
16	contrary, each individual and group accident and health, or
17	sickness policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued or renewed



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1	in this State after December 31, 2011, shall provide coverage or
2	reimbursement for the use of the Lifebed Intelligent Medical
3	Vigilance System for the policyholder and individuals covered
4	under the policy, contract, plan, or agreement."
5	SECTION 3. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
7	and to read as follows:
8	"§432- Coverage for use of the Lifebed Intelligent
9	Medical Vigilance System. Notwithstanding any provision to the
10	contrary, each individual and group accident and health, or
11	sickness policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued or renewed
12	in this State after December 31, 2011, shall provide coverage or
13	reimbursement for the use of the Lifebed Intelligent Medical
14	Vigilance System for the policyholder and individuals covered
15	under the policy, contract, plan, or agreement."
16	SECTION 4. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	"§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
19	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
20	policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
21	January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
22	this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections
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431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116, 431:10A 116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120, 431:10A-121,
 431:10A-125, 431:10A-126, [and] 431:10A-122, and 431:10A and chapter 431M."

SECTION 5. The benefit to be provided by health
maintenance organizations corresponding to the benefit provided
under section 431:10A- , Hawaii Revised Statutes, as contained
in the amendment to section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, in
section 4 of this Act, shall take effect for all policies,
contracts, plans, or agreements issued in the State after
December 31, 2011.
