Section 342H-39, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by amending and subsection (b) to read as follows: 12 "(b) Petty misdemeanor disposal of solid waste is 13 punishable by: 14 A fine of not less than \$500 but not more than \$25,000 (1)15 for each separate offense; Not more than thirty days imprisonment for each 16 (2) **17** offense; or **18** · (3) Revocation or suspension by court order of any 19 contractor's license or any applicable certificate of 20 authorization from the public utilities commission.
