## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. No mortgagee shall initiate or continue with a
 foreclosure proceeding under parts I or II of chapter 667,
 Hawaii Revised Statutes, beginning on the effective date of this
 Act and ending on the date that the federal government releases
 a final public report on any federal investigation into the
 securitization of mortgages.

7 The governor shall issue a proclamation and publish a
8 notice statewide announcing the release of the final public
9 report.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
