## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE AGENCIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 174C-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 3 "(a) There is established within the department a 4 commission on water resource management consisting of [seven] eight members which shall have exclusive jurisdiction and final 5 authority in all matters relating to implementation and 6 administration of the state water code, except as otherwise 7 specifically provided in this chapter. 8 9 Five members shall be appointed by the governor (b) subject to confirmation by the senate, in a manner prescribed in 10 subsection (d). Each member shall have substantial experience 11 in the area of water resource management; provided that at least 12 one member shall have substantial experience or expertise in 13 traditional Hawaiian water resource management techniques and in 14 15 traditional Hawaiian riparian usage such as those preserved by section 174C-101[-]; provided further that one member shall be 16 appointed by the board of trustees of the office of Hawaiian 17

1 affairs. The chairperson of the board of land and natural 2 resources shall be the chairperson of the commission. The 3 director of health shall serve as an ex officio voting member." SECTION 2. Section 171-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 5 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: The board of land and natural resources shall be 6 "(a) 7 composed of [seven] eight members  $[\tau]$  as follows: one appointed by the board of trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs to 8 9 represent the interests of the office of Hawaiian affairs, one from each land district, and three at large, to be nominated 10 and, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, appointed 11 by the governor as provided in section 26-34. The term and 12 removal of a member of the board and the filling of a vacancy on 13 the board shall also be as provided in section 26-34. There 14 shall be not more than three members on the board from the same 15 political party. At least one member of the board shall have a 16 17 background in conservation and natural resources, as evidenced 18 by: (1) A college degree in a relevant field, including 19 20 forestry, wildlife conservation, geology,

environmental science, or marine biology; or



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Work history sufficient to demonstrate an appropriate
 level of knowledge in the subject of land and natural
 resources, including parks and recreation, public
 lands management, natural area reserves, aquatic
 resources, boating and recreation, forestry and
 wildlife, water resources management, or conservation
 and resources."

8 SECTION 3. Section 205-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended to read as follows:

"§205-1 Establishment of the commission. There shall be a 10 state land use commission, hereinafter called the commission. 11 The commission shall consist of [nine] ten members who shall 12 hold no other public office and shall be appointed in the manner 13 and serve for the term set forth in section 26-34. One member 14 shall be appointed from each of the counties, one member shall 15 be appointed by the board of trustees of the office of Hawaiian 16 affairs to represent the interest of the office of Hawaiian 17 affairs, and the remainder shall be appointed at large; provided 18 that one member shall have substantial experience or expertise 19 in traditional Hawaiian land usage and knowledge of cultural 20 land practices. The commission shall elect its chairperson from 21 one of its members. The members shall receive no compensation 22

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for their services on the commission, but shall be reimbursed
 for actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
 Six affirmative votes shall be necessary for any boundary
 amendment.

5 The commission shall be a part of the department of
6 business, economic development, and tourism for administration
7 purposes, as provided for in section 26-35.

8 The commission may engage employees necessary to perform its duties, including administrative personnel and an executive 9 10 officer. The executive officer shall be appointed by the commission and the executive officer's position shall be exempt 11 12 from civil service. Departments of the state government shall 13 make available to the commission [such] any data, facilities, and personnel as are necessary for it to perform its duties. 14 15 The commission may receive and utilize gifts and any funds from the federal or other governmental agencies. It shall adopt 16 rules guiding its conduct, maintain a record of its activities 17 and accomplishments, and make recommendations to the governor 18 19 and to the legislature through the governor."

20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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### Report Title:

Boards and Commissions; Office of Hawaiian Affairs Membership

#### Description:

Increases the membership of the commission on water resource management, board of land and natural resources, and land use commission, respectively, by one member who represents the interests of the office of Hawaiian affairs.

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
