A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 201H-201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 ""Moderate rehabilitation" means rehabilitation to upgrade
- 5 a dwelling unit to a decent, safe, and sanitary condition, or to
- 6 repair or replace major building systems or components in danger
- 7 of failure."
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 10 "(d) The fund shall be used to provide loans or grants for
- 11 the development, pre-development, construction, acquisition,
- 12 preservation, and [substantial] moderate rehabilitation of
- 13 rental housing units. Permitted uses of the fund may include
- 14 but are not limited to planning, design, land acquisition, costs
- 15 of options, agreements of sale, downpayments, equity financing,
- 16 capacity building of nonprofit housing developers, or other
- 17 housing development services or activities as provided in rules
- 18 adopted by the corporation pursuant to chapter 91. The rules

- 1 may provide for a means of recapturing loans or grants made from
- 2 the fund if a rental housing project financed under the fund is
- 3 refinanced or sold at a later date. The rules may also provide
- 4 that moneys from the fund shall be leveraged with other
- 5 financial resources to the extent possible."
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
