### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§281-</u> <u>Caffeinated beer beverage; intoxicating liquor.</u>
5	(a) No person shall sell, offer for sale, advertise, or
6	otherwise distribute any caffeinated beer beverage in the State
7	unless the caffeinated beer beverage is labeled as an
8	"intoxicating liquor" and contains a warning that the potential
9	harmful effects of consuming a caffeinated beer beverage may
10	increase the potential harmful effects of consuming an
11	intoxicating liquor.
12	(b) As used in this section:
13	"Caffeinated beer beverage" means a beverage as defined as
14	beer under section 244D-1, in which caffeine has been
15	intentionally added as a food additive to the beverage.
16	"Food additive" shall have the same meaning as defined in
17	Section 201(s) of the federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

1	(c) This section shall not apply to alcoholic beverages
2	made with ingredients that contain naturally occurring caffeine,
3	including coffee, tea, cacao, or extracts derived from these
4	foods."
5	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
6	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
7	begun before its effective date.
8	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
