4 entered into pursuant to this chapter after December 31, 2012,
5 shall contain a provision that requires the provider to
6 participate in the development or annual review of the health
7 and human services delivery plan."

8 **PART II**

9 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that the department of
10 health's healthy Hawaii initiative conducted a survey of Hawaii
11 employer-union health benefits trust fund members last year at
12 the request of the outgoing trust fund management. The healthy
13 Hawaii initiative made a presentation to the trust fund board
14 regarding favorable responses from members on the following:

- 15 (1) Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund
16 members showed great interest in worksite wellness;
- 17 (2) Opportunities do exist to positively influence healthy
18 behavior related to physical activity and the
19 consumption of fruits and vegetables; and
- 20 (3) The majority of members favor reduced premiums and co-
21 payments for healthy lifestyles, completing health



1 risk assessments, or participating in disease
2 management.

3 The legislature finds that Hawaii must comply with federal
4 health reform legislation requirements by 2014, including
5 mandating physician reimbursements for outcomes rather than
6 transactions. Therefore, the legislature is interested in
7 authorizing and evaluating health and wellness alternatives that
8 reduce the incidence of chronic disease, support state employees
9 in adopting and maintaining healthier lifestyles, and reduce the
10 costs of health-care expenditures associated with emergency care
11 and other hospital-based treatments for avoidable chronic
12 diseases.

13 The purpose of this part is to establish a workplace
14 wellness pilot program.

15 SECTION 3. The department of health shall create a
16 workplace wellness pilot program.

Description:

Requires the directors of health and human services to collaborate with contracted health and human services providers to develop and update annually a health and human services delivery plan. Requires the department of health to establish a workplace wellness pilot program to support state employees in adopting and maintaining healthier lifestyles. Effective July 1, 2030. (SD1)

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
