A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Traffic congestion on the State's roads and 2 highways has severe detrimental impacts on the economy and the 3 quality of life of Hawaii's residents. The statewide population 4 growth, along with the resulting demand for residential 5 development, has substantially contributed to the State's 6 traffic concerns. Ensuring that roads are built before the 7 construction of residential developments will help avoid the 8 gridlock that has already affected various communities.

9 The legislature notes that a state constitutional amendment 10 was introduced in the 2011 Regular Session that would allow. 11 special purpose revenue bonds to be issued and used to assist 12 developers to provide infrastructure, including highway 13 improvements. The legislature finds that this would 14 dramatically speed up the process of funding needed roads and 15 infrastructure throughout the State.

16 The purpose of this Act is to require responsible county 17 agencies, as a condition precedent to the issuance of any 18 grubbing, grading, or building permit for any residential HB LRB 11-0696-1.doc

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1 development, to certify that all highways that are or will be 2 contiguous to the residential development have been completed or 3 are under construction. 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 5 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 6 read as follows: 7 "§46- Highway development, residential developments. 8 (a) As a condition precedent to the issuance of any grubbing, 9 grading, or building permit for any portion or phase of a 10 residential development, the county agency responsible for issuing the permit shall certify on the permit that all county 11 12 and state highways that are or will be contiguous to the 13 residential development have been completed or are under 14 construction at the time of issuance of the permit. 15 (b) For purposes of this section: 16 "Residential development" means any development that 17 comprises over residential units. 18 "Residential unit" includes single-family, duplex, and multi-family units." 19 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 20



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1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
