Instructional Days; Multi-Track Public Schools

Description:

Provides an exemption to multi-track public schools of the minimum number of days and instructional hours required of other non-charter public schools by requiring these schools to meet the greater of one hundred seventy-one days or ninety percent of the minimum number of days, and at least ninety percent of the minimum number of student instructional hours for each respective school year. Includes reporting requirements. (HB945 HD2)
