A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the [20112013] 2014-2016 school years, all public schools, except charter
schools[7] and multi-track public schools, shall implement a
school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional
development days and other non-instructional days negotiated
pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include:

10 (1) Nine hundred fifteen student instructional hours for
11 the elementary school grades; and

12 (2) Nine hundred ninety student instructional hours for13 the secondary school grades.

(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
[2013-2015] 2016-2018 school years, all public schools, except
charter schools[7] and multi-track public schools, shall
implement a school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding
professional development days and other non-instructional days
