A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of		
2	human services receives federal and state funds to administer		
3	the State's public assistance programs. Because tax revenues		
4	are used to fund public assistance programs, the legislature i		
5	concerned that these programs are administered in the most		
6	effective and efficient manner possible. The legislature		
7	believes that any opportunity to defraud or abuse these		
8	important public assistance programs should be addressed and		
9	rectified.		
10	SECTION 2. The auditor shall conduct a financial and		
11	management audit of the department of human services relating t		
12	the public assistance programs that the department administers		
13	under section 346-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The audit shall		
14	include but not be limited to a determination of:		
15	(1) The amount of federal funds received to administer		
16	each public assistance program;		

(2) The amount of state funds received to administer each

public assistance program;

1	(3)	Compliance with both federal and state laws relating	
2		to restrictions on funding of these programs;	
3	(4)	The number of public assistance recipients for each	
4		<pre>public assistance program;</pre>	
5	(5)	Whether each public assistance program is implemented	
6		and managed in a manner that conforms with the purpose	
7		of the program and in a manner that is effective and	
8		efficient; and	
9	(6)	To what extent any public assistance program is	
10		vulnerable to fraud or abuse and whether there has	
11		been any significant incidence of fraud or abuse in	
12		any program.	
13	SECTION 3. The auditor shall submit a report with finding		
14	and recommendations, including any proposed legislation,		
15	concerning, among other things, the department of human		
16	services' use of federal and state funds relating to the		
17	implementation of the State's public assistance programs and th		
18	efficient and effective management of these programs, to the		
19	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of		
20	the 2012 regular session.		

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
