### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE COUNCIL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow the state 2 fire council to establish two staff positions to carry out its 3 statutory duties and responsibilities, including adopting a 4 state fire code, applying for and administering state fire-5 related grants, administering the reduced ignition propensity 6 cigarette program mandated under chapter 132C, Hawaii Revised 7 Statutes, coordinating statewide fire and life safety training 8 and education, inspecting state buildings and facilities, and 9 collecting data. Additionally, the state fire council advises 10 the governor and the legislature on fire and life safety issues, 11 implements statewide mutual aid agreements, prescribes standard 12 procedures and forms relating to inspections, investigations, 13 and reporting of fires, and is a voting member of the state 14 building code council.

15 SECTION 2. Section 132-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended to read as follows:
