HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING WHOLESALERS AND RETAILERS IN HAWAII TO VOLUNTARILY REFRAIN FROM SELLING, PURCHASING, AND DISTRIBUTING PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN BISPHENOL-A.

WHEREAS, Bisphenol-A, commonly abbreviated as BPA, is a 1 synthetic compound used primarily in the manufacture of plastic 2 items, including some baby bottles and sippy cups, infant 3 formula cans and jars, food and drink containers, and reusable 4 5 water bottles; and 6 7 WHEREAS, according to many experts, Bisphenol-A is linked to a wide range of health problems, including adverse effects on 8 fetal and infant behavior and brain development, obesity and 9 associated diseases, thyroid function, and breast cancer; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the adverse health effects are even more 12 pronounced in babies, toddlers, and children; and 13 14 WHEREAS, several jurisdictions have banned Bisphenol-A from 15 certain children's food and beverage containers, including 16 Chicago, Minnesota, Connecticut, and Canada; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the current market provides similar plastic 19 products manufactured without Bisphenol-A; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the residents of Hawaii, and especially keiki, 22 should not be subject to unnecessary health risks; now, 23 therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 26 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 27 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that wholesalers and retailers 28 that operate in the State are requested to voluntarily refrain 29 from selling, purchasing, and distributing products that contain 30
