HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CONVENING OF A TASK FORCE TO REPORT ON STRATEGIES AND RESOURCES TO REDUCE RECIDIVISM AMONG NATIVE HAWAIIANS.

WHEREAS, there is a concern for the health and welfare of 1 2 Native Hawaiian inmates in prisons in Hawaii and the continental 3 United States; and 4 5 WHEREAS, due to a number of historic and socioeconomic factors, Native Hawaiians make up a disproportionately high 6 percentage of the inmate population in the state prison system, 7 accounting for twenty-four percent of the overall state 8 9 population but thirty-nine percent of the incarcerated 10 population; and 11 12 WHEREAS, in response to those concerns, the Office of 13 Hawaiian Affairs, in collaboration with public and private entities, published a report entitled "The Disparate Treatment 14 of Native Hawaiians in the Criminal Justice System" in September 15 16 2010; and 17 WHEREAS, this report found that, when controlled for all 18 factors except ethnicity, Native Hawaiians face disparate 19 treatment in the Hawaii criminal justice system in many areas, 20 including but not limited to longer prison sentences, 21 probations, and a higher percentage of parole revocations; and 22 23 WHEREAS, as detailed in the report, two of the key factors 24 that contribute to recidivism are a lack of standard and 25 culturally-based programs in prison to adequately prepare an 26 inmate for reentry into society; now, therefore, 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 29 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 30 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Office of Hawaiian 31 Affairs is requested to convene a task force for the purpose of 32

producing a comprehensive report on strategies and resources 1 needed to reduce recidivism among Native Hawaiians; and 2 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 4 submit the report to the Governor and the Legislature no later 5 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 6 of 2012; and 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 9 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director 10 of Public Safety, and Office of Hawaiian Affairs. 11 12 13 14 OFFERED BY:
