HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO ENSURE THAT THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICERS COMPLY WITH THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CODE PREFERENCES FOR HAWAII PRODUCTS TO PROMOTE GROWTH OF THE STATE'S AGRICULTURE INDUSTRY AND THEREBY ASSURE FOOD SECURITY FOR HAWAII'S CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, the food security of the State of Hawaii is 1 dependent upon a vibrant and expanding local agriculture 2 industry; and 3 4 WHEREAS, section 103D-1002, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 5 provides a preference for purchases of Hawaii products, 6 including food raised or grown within the State; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the statutory preference for government purchases 9 of Hawaii products provides Hawaii agricultural producers with a 10 reliable market and creates economic incentives for the 11 expansion of the Hawaii agriculture industry; and 12 13 WHEREAS, part IX of chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 14 provides for assistance to small business and a preference for 15 geographic bidding; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the majority of Hawaii agriculture businesses 18 qualify as a "small business", as defined in section 103D-901, 19 Hawaii Revised Statutes, and are eligible for certain bid 20 solicitation treatment under the Hawaii Public Procurement Code; 21 and 22 23 WHEREAS, aggressive implementation of existing Hawaii 24 Public Procurement Code preferences for Hawaii products and 25 small businesses will ensure that Hawaii agriculture businesses 26 have a reliable market, and will promote growth in Hawaii's 27 ability to produce food and other agricultural products; and 28 29
