HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO EXAMINE HOW THE COMPENSATION OF STATE AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE COMPARES WITH THAT OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES IN OTHER STATES AND JURISDICTIONS AND THAT OF THE PRIVATE SECTOR IN THE STATE.

WHEREAS, the cost of living in Hawaii is estimated to be 30 to 60 percent higher than the national average; and

WHEREAS, the higher cost of living in Hawaii is due in large part to higher housing costs compared with other states; and

WHEREAS, the prospect of earning higher wages elsewhere prompts many Hawaii residents to relocate to other states and to jobs in the private sector; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that since the state and county governments employ a significant portion of Hawaii's workforce, it would be prudent to examine how the compensation of state and county employees in the State compares with that of other states and jurisdictions when factoring in the cost of living in Hawaii; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Director of Human Resources Development is requested to establish the Hawaii Government Employees Compensation Task Force (Task Force) to examine how the compensation of state and county employees in the State compares with the compensation of government employees in other states and jurisdictions when factoring in the cost of living in Hawaii; and
