HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT ITS RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER SECTION 5 OF ACT 178, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2006.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii Public Housing Authority was 1 established to provide affordable housing and shelter to Hawaii 2 residents without discrimination; and 3 4 WHEREAS, only with accurate and complete reporting and 5 6 accounting can the Hawaii Public Housing Authority effectively carry out its mission and its responsibilities to other 7 departments and agencies; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006 (Act 178), was enacted in part to identify revenue-generating public trust 11 lands and the amounts derived from those lands by requiring the 12 13 Department of Land and Natural Resources, with the cooperation of the Department of Budget and Finance and any other state 14 department or agency that uses or manages public lands, to 15 annually provide an accounting of all receipts from lands 16 17 described in section 5(f) of the Admission Act for the prior fiscal year; and 18 19 WHEREAS, under section 5, the annual accounting must 20 21 contain specific information with respect to each receipt, for example the total gross amount, the amount transferred to the 22 Office of Hawaiian Affairs, and the parcel of land that 23 generated the receipt; and 24 25 WHEREAS, although the Hawaii Public Housing Authority is 26 subject to Act 178, the Department of Land and Natural Resources 27 has not received a revenue report from the Hawaii Public Housing 28 Authority for fiscal years 2006-2007 and 2007-2008, and reported 29 30 to the Legislature in 2008, that: 31 HCR168 HD1 HMS 2011-3443

1 "According to its [Hawaii Public Housing 2 Authority's] Fiscal Office, the accounting system has been unreliable for the last several years, and is not 3 capable of producing an accurate report. They are in 4 5 the process of reconstructing their books from scratch"; 6 7 8 and 9 10 WHEREAS, it is unclear whether the Hawaii Public Housing Authority has completed this process or has ever submitted a 11 12 completed revenue report to the Department of Land and Natural 13 Resources; and 14 WHEREAS, the lack of readily-available and accurate 15 information on the Hawaii Public Housing Authority's revenues 16 and the resulting negative impact on the State's full compliance 17 18 with Act 178, raises serious concerns; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 21 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Public Housing 22 23 Authority is requested to carry out its accounting and reporting responsibilities under Section 5 of Act 178, Session Laws of 24 Hawaii 2006; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Public Housing 27 Authority is requested to submit a report of its progress in 28 carrying out these responsibilities to the Legislature no later 29 30 than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 31 2012; and 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 33 34 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, Director of Land and Natural Resources, Board of Directors of the Hawaii 35 Public Housing Authority, and Chairperson of the Board of 36 Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. 37
