HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONSTRUCT A CROSSWALK ON UPPER AIKI STREET ALONG KUPUNA LOOP IN VILLAGE PARK FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.

WHEREAS, Hawaii is committed to maintaining and improving 1 its neighborhood quality of life and livability; and 2 3 WHEREAS, traffic safety and walkability of our 4 5 neighborhoods are priorities for Hawaii; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Hawaii averages 28 pedestrian fatalities each year 8 and 560 pedestrian injuries from being struck by motorists, 9 giving Hawaii the fourth highest pedestrian fatality rate, per capita, in the United States; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the majority of fatalities occurred because people 12 failed to use crosswalks and did not cross at intersections; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the most common reason why pedestrians were struck 15 is because drivers failed to yield the right of way or were 16 inattentive; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the residents of Village Park are in need of 19 traffic safety improvements, particularly on busy Aiki Street 20 and Kupuna Loop, where there is a high mix of cars and 21 22 pedestrians; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Village Park residents for years have sought a crosswalk on upper Aiki Street along Kupuna Loop that would be 25 visible to motorists, and help pedestrians, many of whom are 26 young or elderly, safely cross the busy roadway; now, therefore, 27
