18	a certificate of need to a health care facility for capital
19 20	improvements be consistent with the State Health Services and
20	Facilities Plan and, if requested by the health care facility,
21 22	also be done through the public hearings process; and
22 23	WHEREAS, a denial of a certificate of need may prevent a
23 24	health care facility from receiving reimbursements for Medicare
25	and Medicaid; now, therefore,
