## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO CONSIDER IMPLEMENTING A COMPUTER APPLICATION FOR FOSTER YOUTH WHO ARE TRANSITIONING OUT OF THE FOSTER CARE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the transition from foster care to adulthood is a 1 very difficult path for many former foster care individuals; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, former foster youth frequently leave foster care with little more than paper copies of essential personal 5 information; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, former foster youth may not have a permanent living arrangement established and may move from house to house, 9 and in this process may lose their vital documents; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, losing vital documents may present obstacles to 13 former foster youth when applying for a job, completing an application to college, or receiving medical care; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, to address this challenge, a leading information technology and business process services provider, developed a 17 computer application; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, this secure, password-protected, web-based foster 21 youth computer application can be accessed from any computer; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, this computer application houses a foster youth's health and education information and personal and professional 25 contacts, and allows for the upload and storage of personal 26 documents such as a copy of a birth certificate, social security 27 card, and resume; and 28 29 WHEREAS, a leading information technology and business 30 process services provider is seeking a partnership with a state 31

1 department that would be interested in implementing this 2 computer application on a statewide basis; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services is the state department that provides independent living services to assist 5 and support foster youth with their transition from foster care 6 7 to adult self-sufficiency; now, therefore, 8 9 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 10 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Human 11 Services is encouraged to consider partnering with a leading 12 information technology and business process services provider 13 to implement a computer application throughout the State's 14 foster care system as a means to assist and support foster youth 15 with their successful transition out of foster care; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 18 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human 19 20 Services, Executive Director of Mental Health America of Hawai'i, and members of the Hawaii Transition Age Youth Task Force. 21 22 23 24 25
