# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE MAYOR OF HONOLULU AND THE HONOLULU CITY COUNCIL TO  
ALLOW AN EXEMPTION FROM SECTION 15-4.1 OF THE REVISED  
ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU TO ALLOW FOR STREET PARKING IN THE  
COMMUNITY OF HO'OKEA IN EWA VILLAGES.

1           WHEREAS, the community of Ho'okea in Ewa Villages is an  
2 affordable housing project built by the City and County of  
3 Honolulu in 1970; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, the housing and road designs in Ewa Villages were  
6 constructed according to the standards of that time period and  
7 they have severely limited the availability of parking within  
8 the Ho'okea community; and  
9

10           WHEREAS, Ho'okea comprises only six streets: Halolani,  
11 Auwaha, Paeko, Kamahoi, Olehala, and Maliko; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, Ho'okea is a high density area in which many  
14 families own more than one motor vehicle; and  
15

16           WHEREAS, a City and County of Honolulu ordinance that  
17 regulates street parking, Revised Ordinance of Honolulu section  
18 15-14.2, was enacted in 1978; and  
19

20           WHEREAS, section 15-14.1 of the Revised Ordinances of  
21 Honolulu prohibits stopping, standing, or parking a vehicle in  
22 specified places, including in front of a public or private  
23 driveway or within four feet of either side of a public or  
24 private driveway; and

26           WHEREAS, the provisions of section 15-14.1 of the Revised  
27 Ordinances of Honolulu have greatly inconvenienced Ho'okea  
28 residents due to their inability to park their motor vehicles  
29 near their residences; and

1 WHEREAS, the layout of the neighborhood of Ho'okea was not  
2 designed to comply with section 15-14.1 of the Revised  
3 Ordinances of Honolulu; now, therefore,  
4

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
6 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
7 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Mayor of the City and  
8 County of Honolulu and Chairperson of the Honolulu City Council  
9 are urged to allow an exemption from section 15-14.1 of the  
10 Revised Ordinances of Honolulu for residents of the Ho'okea  
11 community to allow them to park their vehicles near their  
12 residences; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
15 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City  
16 and County of Honolulu, Chairperson of the Honolulu City  
17 Council, and the Director of the Department of Planning and  
18 Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu.
