HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO DETERMINE WHETHER CHILDREN OF FAMILIES RECEIVING TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES FEDERAL FUNDS HAVE A HIGHER RATE OF TRUANCY.

WHEREAS, temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) 1 funds are federal block grants that provide states, territories, 2 and tribes with federal funds each year to cover benefits, 3 4 administrative expenses, and services for low-income families; 5 and 6 WHEREAS, the TANF block grant is administered by state, 7 territorial, and tribal agencies that provide assistance and 8 work opportunities to low-income families through welfare 9 programs that promote employment, responsibility, and self-10 sufficiency; and 11 12 WHEREAS, education is a key method for families to improve 13 14 their financial situation and attain self-sufficiency; and 15 WHEREAS, encouraging the education of children from 16 households that receive TANF funds promotes the goals of the 17 TANF program and serves an important educational purpose; now, 18 19 therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 22 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 23 Education, with assistance from the Department of Human 24 25 Services, is requested to determine whether children of families receiving TANF funds have a higher rate of truancy or excessive 26 absenteeism from school and to make recommendations to address 27 this issue; and 28 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is 31 requested to consider programs designed to encourage or ensure
