HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO ENFORCE THE FEDERAL TRADEMARK FOR KONA COFFEE.

1 WHEREAS, Kona coffee is world renowned for its deliciously rich, medium-bodied, and slightly acidic flavor, as well as its 2 3 heady aroma; and 4 WHEREAS, Kona coffee is grown on the dark volcanic lava 5 6 rock slopes of Kona along the west coast of the Big Island, an 7 area that has been producing coffee continuously since the early 8 1800s; and 9 WHEREAS, Kona coffee trees thrive in the unique combination 10 of sunshine, rainfall, location, and volcanic soil - only 11 available in Kona - to allow for the creation of award-winning 12 coffees; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Kona coffee farmers have honed their skills over 15 many generations in meticulously cultivating and processing 16 17 coffee beans; and 18

19 WHEREAS, the reputation for world-class excellence that 20 defines Kona coffee has made it one of the most expensive 21 coffees in the world, which has resulted in attempts to exploit 22 the Kona name; and

24 WHEREAS, one of the most egregious cases occurred in the 25 1990s, when a company called Kona Kai Farms was found to have 26 put Central American coffee into bags with labels indicating it 27 was Kona coffee; and

WHEREAS, to protect the reputation of bona-fide Kona
coffee, the Hawaii Department of Agriculture secured a federal
certification mark for 100 percent Kona coffee which provides an
assurance of origin and quality; and

WHEREAS, vigilant enforcement of the Kona coffee trademark
 is needed to prevent the sale and distribution of counterfeit
 coffee labeled as Kona coffee; now, therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 7 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 8 Agriculture is requested to enforce the federal trademark for 9 Kona coffee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
Board of Agriculture.
