HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING AND REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO ESTABLISH A SISTER-STATE RELATIONSHIP THROUGH THE HAWAII SISTER-STATE COMMITTEE BETWEEN THE STATE OF HAWAII OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE STATE OF RABAT-SALÉ-ZEMMOUR-ZAËR OF THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO.

WHEREAS, Hawaii maintains a heritage of international 1 participation and cultural sensitivity unparalleled in other 2 3 states due to its multicultural population since the reign of the Hawaiian monarchy in the early 19th century; and 4 5 WHEREAS, since 1981, the Legislature has instituted sister-6 7 state relationships as a means of asserting its active 8 participation in international matters; and 9 WHEREAS, Hawaii currently maintains 15 sister-state 10 11 relationships; and 12 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds it advantageous to continue 13 to pursue sister-state relationships, for both cultural and 14 economic development reasons, with attention focused on 15 16 fostering the most productive ties; and 17 WHEREAS, Hawaii initiated informal relations with the 18 Moroccan state of Rabat-Salé-Zemmour-Zaër, as both states hosted 19 a World Youth Congress assembly administered by Peace Child 20 International of the United Kingdom; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, the Legislature extends its gratitude to His Majesty King Mohammed VI for graciously hosting Hawaii's 24 designated representative to Morocco at the Moroccan-hosted 25 Second World Youth Congress in August, 2003; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the Legislature notes many other connections 28 between our states, including the semester-long visit of Mr. 29

Driss Semlani, a teacher from El Malek Assaadi High School in 1 Kenitra, Morocco, to Hawaii in the spring of 2002 as part of the 2 New Initiative Teacher Exchange program, an initiative of the 3 United States Department of State and the Moroccan-American 4 5 Commission for Educational and Cultural Exchange; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Jan Rumi, who attended the Second World Youth 8 Congress in 2003 as an adult observer, is now serving as the 9 Honorary Consul for the Kingdom of Morocco located in Honolulu; 10 and 11 12 WHEREAS, the state of Rabat-Salé-Zemmour-Zaër maintains a population of about 2,000,000 residents, three-fourths of whom 13 live in urban areas on the eastern Atlantic coast, including the 14 city of Rabat, the seat of the Kingdom of Morocco; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that the negotiations have 18 been completed between the United States government and the 19 Kingdom of Morocco and a free trade agreement has been secured 20 as part of the Middle East Free Trade Area Initiative of 21 President George W. Bush; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the Legislature believes this relationship would 24 be mutually beneficial and sustainable, advancing its goals for 25 international peace and brotherhood; now, therefore, 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 28 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Governor is authorized 29 30 and requested to take all necessary actions to establish a sister-state relationship through the Hawaii Sister-State 31 Committee between Hawaii and the state of Rabat-Salé-Zemmour-32 33 Zaër, Kingdom of Morocco, to include economic, social, 34 governmental, educational, and cultural exchange; and 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state of Rabat-Salé-36 37 Zemmour-Zaër be offered the privileges and honors that Hawaii 38 extends to its sister-states and provinces; and 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor and the Hawaii 40 41 Sister-State Committee are requested to report to the 42 Legislature on the progress made with respect to this Concurrent 43 Resolution no later than 20 days before the convening of the 44 Regular Session of 2012; and z

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the business community of 6 Hawaii is also requested to assist in the matters proposed by 7 this Concurrent Resolution, as in all matters concerning sister-8 state relations; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the United States 11 Secretary of State, King of Morocco, Prime Minister of the 12 Kingdom of Morocco, United States Ambassador-designee to the 13 14 Kingdom of Morocco, Moroccan Ambassador to the United States, 15 Congressional delegation from Hawaii, Governor of Hawaii, 16 Governor of the state of Rabat-Salé-Zemmour-Zaër, Chairperson of the Hawaii Sister-State Committee, President of the University 17 18 of Hawaii, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Chamber 19 of Commerce of Hawaii, and Honorary Consul for the Kingdom of Morocco in Hawaii. 20
