## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO CONTINUE TO ENGAGE IN DATA EXCHANGES IN ORDER TO VERIFY THE ELIGIBILITY OF RECIPIENTS OF MEDICAID ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, the State expends over \$1,000,000,000 annually on 1 Medicaid assistance; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, the State needs to ensure that the recipients of Medicaid assistance are eligible to receive that assistance; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services administers the 7 Medicaid assistance program for the State; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services requires data 10 held by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations in 11 12 order to verify the eligibility of recipients of Medicaid assistance; now, therefore, 13 14 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 16 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Labor and 17 Industrial Relations and the Department of Human Services are 18 requested to continue to engage in data exchanges in order to 19 verify the eligibility of recipients of Medicaid assistance; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the departments are requested 22 to ensure that any data exchanged between them is handled in a 23 secure and appropriate manner; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the departments are requested 26 27 to submit a report of any actions taken pursuant to this Concurrent Resolution, findings and recommendations, and any 28 proposed legislation, to the Legislature not later than twenty 29 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and 30 HCR254 HD1 HUS.doc
