5 6 7 8	WHEREAS, in 2005, the Legislature embraced sustainability as a guiding principle in the future development and land use management of the Hawaiian Islands when it established the Hawaii 2050 Task Force; and
9 10 11 12	WHEREAS, the native Hawaiian land tenure system recognized the interconnectedness of island ecosystems whose health was necessary to the survival of native Hawaiian communities; and
13 14 15 16 17	WHEREAS, conducting research and collecting data on marine protected areas will provide information that will lead to a greater understanding of these areas by a wider circle of stakeholders; now, therefore,
18 19 20 21 22 23 24	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the University of Hawaii at Hilo's Pacific Aquaculture and Coastal Resources Center convene a working group of interested stakeholders to examine the feasibility of establishing a research program to:
